6 Golf Skills:

Long Putt	Iron
Chip Shot	Driver

During practices, volunteer instructors teach golf fundamentals and share their love of the game with the attendees. Participants who master the basics and pass a skills test can begin to play a 9-Hole Alternate Shot format with an experienced partner.

Participants in the KBDF Special Needs Golf Program also have the opportunity to take part in various tournaments, competing against other teams in skills-based contests and Partner Alternate Shot Competitions.
